One advantage of being active in the transgender community is that it's given me a great core group of friends; a group that respects and appreciates me as I come to terms with myself and determine if transition is in my future. However, there's one big difference between my friends and me...about 25-30 years.

Yes, I'm only 26 years old. I'm one of the youngest members of the Erie Sisters and I've been active in the TG community since 2007. While my journey has introduced me to some awesome people and opened my life up to so much, one thing has been missing. It's those relationships with people my own age. It always adds that special connection and I've found it much easier to relate.

In the last six years, I've tried reaching out to



I want them to know that it's OK to come out and be who you are, even if you're just exploring or questioning. There are others out there like you in the same situation. Is it going to be hard? 


