Pennsylvania Equality Project - Ban Conversion Therapy Efforts

Pennsylvania Equality Project (PEP) is counting on Erie County, and our US Congress to take action that our General Assembly in Harrisburg has failed to address. We seek a ban on the use of conversion therapy on minors by health care professionals in Erie County, Pennsylvania. Ideally, a ban would exist statewide.

Already, the cities of Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, Allentown, Reading, Doylestown Borough, and now State College have banned the practice within their respective jurisdictions. 




