





## **Review:**

Star Trek FAQ by Mark Clark (Applause Theatre and Cinema Books)

Hello my fellow nerds, Trekkies, and Trekkers! When handed the assignment of reading *Star Trek FAQ*, I thought, "oh sure . . . stuff I am sure I have already heard a thousand times" and "yes, I know what a phaser is!" Well, this book is so much more.

Mark Clark has brilliantly written a book that could teach a college level course on the original series of Star Trek. This book is no mere episode companion or a technical guide to starships. Instead, the reader is getting a history of what Trek is and where it came from. We find ourselves not just wrapped up in the story of how the series first started, but exactly which authors, books, movies, and science fiction characters were specific influences to the show. We also learn the history of Trek's creator, Gene Roddenberry, outside of Star Trek. He was a military pilot and commercial pilot, an LA Police Officer, and consultant and writer for other shows before the creation of Star Trek. Mark Clark also informs us of a surprising champion for Star Trek, Lucille Ball.

Star Trek FAQ also gives us the stories behind the array of guest stars, a look at the ill-fated "red shirts," character and cast bios, how various props were created and where they came from, and how aliens and their worlds were made. We even get an overview of the "beam me up Scotty" styled quotes and one-liners (by the way, we never hear "beam me up Scotty" in the original series—it first appeared on a 1970's bumper sticker).

And for you non-Trekkies/Trekkers, you may be interested in the information regarding the technology of Star Trek. Most of us walk around daily, texting and soaking in data from the sky using our "communicators" and "Universal Translators." Our everyday lives are enriched by technology inspired by Trek, and we benefit from those scientists who are still inspired everyday by this great show.

Whether you are a die-hard fan, an all-around Sci-Fi buff, or just curious, there is so much to be learned from *Star Trek FAQ*. And, you find yourself as eager as I for the 2013 release of FAQ 2!
