



Persad Center Friends for Life Program

In 2009, studies found that suicide was the third leading cause of death for individuals age 10-24. Numerous studies report that LGBT youth are three times more likely to attempt suicide than their straight peers. Persad Center, is taking a stand to prevent youth suicide. This year Persad Center will train 15 or more youth on suicide prevention. Youth will get an opportunity to impact their community with a youth lead community service projects that will be centered on suicide prevention.

Persad Center, through the implementation of the Safe Spaces project, will offer counseling, mental health screenings, referrals, peer leadership, and many opportunities for suicide prevention to individuals ages 14 - 21. The Safe Spaces project will provide suicide prevention training and will empower youth to lead activities for other youth within the community. Youth will be educated on LGBTQ specific concerns and issues, including but not limited to suicide prevention. Meetings will be held on the 1st and 3rd Monday of
