## Erie same-sex couple married after first judge refuses

A same-sex couple that Senior District Judge Joseph Lefaiver refused to marry were married a week later by Erie 3rd Ward District Judge Tom Carney on Sept. 8, 2014.

Cynthia Baker, 38, and Carrie Ann Loesel, 43, had originally made arrangements with staff at the 5th Ward District office to be married by a judge there. An office staff member said that, as is standard procedure, arrangments were made by staff, including handling of fees. Arrangments were made by phone, and only the surname was taken. When Senior District Judge Joseph Lefaiver realized that this was a same-sex couple, he refused to perform the service, citing personal beliefs. A




