Keystone Pride Conference Roundtable

On March 20, the Keystone Pride Conference brought together ten pride organizations from Pennsylvania, New Jersey, and New York. NW PA Pride Alliance was represented by board president Alex Sphon and entertainment coordinator Tony Gressley. TransFamily of Erie was represented by their organization's president, Caitlyn Strohmeyer.

The groups from Philadelphia, New Hope, Harrisburg, northwestern Pennsylvania, Reading, northeastern Pennsylvania, Chester County, Schuylkill County, Rowan University, South Jersey, and Staten Island discussed the topics of volunteers, entertainment, youth participation, and Trans inclusion (with the latter being lead by NW PA Pride and TransFamily of Erie).

The groups met at the State Capitol building, in a room secured by Rep. Brian Sims. About halfway through the day-long event, Governor Tom Wolf stopped by to thank the organizers for their work and promised to move the Fairness Act through the General Assembly as soon as possible.

Gov Wolf Expands Non-Discrimination Protections for State Workers, Contractors

Harrisburg, PA, April 7, 2016 – Governor Tom Wolf signed two executive orders that expand protections from discrimination based on sexual orientation, gender expression or identity for state employees and, for the first time, employees of contractors doing business with the commonwealth. Governor Wolf's executive orders come as the Pennsylvania Fairness Act, which would apply these protections to all Pennsylvania workers, remains stalled in the General Assembly.

"With no sign that Republican leaders plan to free this bill that has broad, bi-partisan support, I am taking action to protect those that I can and send a signal to the country that Pennsylvania is open for business no matter who you are or whom you love," Governor Wolf said. "What happened in North Carolina, and what is going on in other states, should be a call to pass non-discrimination legislation in Pennsylvania now."





Recap: Erie Transgender Day of Visibility

On Thursday, March 31, Erie observed the International Transgender Day of Visibility for the first time. Transgender community members and their friends and family came together to talk about the discrimination and difficulties faced by transgender people, but also their strength and growth, and to advocate for Pennsylvania to pass the Fairness Act. Currently, there is nothing at the state level that protects people in the areas of employment, housing and public accommodations on the bases of gender identity, gender expression or sexual orientation. Those categories have been covered by the Erie County Human Relations Commission since March 8, 2002.

Erie Times News covered the event and included a photo and article in the next day's edition.

Speakers at the event included Caitlyn Strohmeyer, Melanie Shubitowski, Tyler James Titus, and Jewels, an 11 year old trans girl. Supporters spoke as well, including Ashley, a professor at Behrend writing a children's book for trans youth as a community project.

The event was initially organized by Daye Pope of Equality PA Trans and Caitlyn Strohmeyer of Trans-Family of NW PA. The event was originally slated to be in Perry Square, but was moved to the Mental Health Association of NW PA, 1101 Peach St, Erie PA, due to thunderstorms in the weather forecast.
