Potential Rise for New Mpox Cases

Erie County Department of Health, CDC

In the US, mpox cases (formerly monkeypox) have reduced since August 2022. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention gets reports of cases from ongoing transmission in the US. From April 17 to May 5, 2023, a total of 12 confirmed and one probable case of mpox were reported to the Chicago Department of Public Health. All cases were men showing symptoms. None of the patients have been hospitalized. Nine cases were among men who had received 2 JYNNEOS vaccine doses. Vaccination

is one of the best prevention measures. New cases among vaccinated people can occur. People who have completed their two-dose JYNNEOS vaccine series may experience less severe symptoms than those who have not. Anyone, regardless of sexual orientation or gender identity, who has been in close, personal contact with someone who has mpox is at risk. There are recommended prevention steps and including vaccination if you are exposed to mpox or have a higher risk of being exposed. Vaccination can help protect yourself and your loved ones.

There four steps we can take to protect ourselves from getting mpox are: 1) avoid close, skin-toskin contact with people who have a rash [which may appear as pimples, blisters, or scabs], 2) avoid contact with objects and materials that a person with mpox has used, 3) wash your hands often with soap and water; especially before touching your face and after using the bathroom, 4) get vaccinated – JYNNEOS is a 2-dose vaccine developed to protect against mpox and smallpox infections. People need to get both doses of the vaccine for the best protection against

mpox. The second dose should be given 4 weeks after the first dose. Mpox vaccines are free, but providers may bill a program or plan to cover the mpox vaccine administration fee (like your private insurance or Medicare/Medicaid). Warren County Pride Speaks at Be Well Collaborative Luncheon

Warren County Pride, Incorporated (WCPI) was invited to speak at Be Well Collaborative's monthly luncheon held at the YMCA of Warren County, PA.

Jill Sumner, the vice-president of WCPI, traced the history of WCPI across the past four years and discussed the evolution of the event from a 40-person rally in a tiny corner park to an all-day festival with performers, a live DJ, costume contests, and nearly 100 tables that hosts thousands of people. She talked about the year-round event-planning process and the dedication of the WCPI teams.

Sumner spoke on the history of pride month, including the Stonewall riots. She reviewed the basic LGBTQ flags. She also talked about the importance of allies not only in the general community, but also, in the workplace, and provided some examples of ally-ship.

Erin Wallace, YMCA program coordinator, and collaborative facilitator, went on to discuss the high rate of suicide and attempted suicide among the LGBTQ community, especially LGBTQ youth. Wallace talked about support groups such as the Trevor Project, and why these supports are vital to building safe communities.

Be Well Collaborative was created to address mental wellness using a community care model. They focus on mental health through the use of health wellness for all. The collaborative is a group of likeminded agencies, businesses, and individuals that have joined together to create a network of support within the Warren community and is coordinated through the Warren County YMCA.

Their mission statement reads: Be Well Collaborative elevates well-being among all in mind, body, and spirit by fostering communication and collaboration.

Sweet Treats at Romolo Chocolates

Looking for a sweet treat? Go no further than Romolo Chocolates. I had the opportunity to talk with owner Tony Stefanelli, chocolatier, about this longtime business. Tony's grandfather, Romolo Stefanelli (for whom Romolo's is named), immigrated to the United States in the early 1900's settling in New York City. In 1926, he and his wife Elizabeth moved to Erie and opened Stefanelli's Candies. It was from his grandfather that Tony learned the art of the chocolatier. In 1993 Stefanelli's Candies was sold outside of the family. Unable to carry on his grandfather's business then, he and his wife Jennie opened Romolo Chocolates a year later in a 3000-square-foot space on West 12th Street. In 2003 they moved the business to a 14,000-square-foot space at its current location

in the Frontier Park area. After several expansions, they now occupy a 30,000-square-foot space at that location, adding the Cocoa Cafe and the Mercato Gift Shop to the site. Thanks in part to COVID, they have also expanded their shipping operations.

A family business, Tony's two sons work to carry the business into the future. His son Anthony works as a chocolatier, and his son Roman works as a cook, preparing all those delicious insides. Tony's wife, Jennie, is the chef for the cafe. She and her staff prepare a wide range of treats that are available at the cafe. In keeping with the traditions established by Romolo, they insist on using the best ingredients for both their candy and cafe products, even if they have to spend a little more. Following these traditions, a piece of Romolo candy made today will taste exactly like it did when the store first opened. In addition to baked goods, they also serve ice cream made on site at the cafe. While most ice cream made in the U.S. goes through a process that adds air to the mixture,

more flavor in the end product.

Tony takes pride in his diverse workforce, and there is no room for intolerance. On a brief tour of the facilities, I saw a clean, well organized, and friendly work environment. So if you are looking for a sweet treat or some nice gifts, or you just want to relax with a cup of coffee at the cafe, visit Romolo Chocolates at 1525 West 8th Street from 8:00 AM to 8:00 PM Monday-Friday, 9:00 AM to 8:00 PM Saturday, and 10:00 AM - 5:00 PM Sunday. There have also been symposiums hosting local workers addressing many topics regarding the LGBT community.

In continuing the conversation of equality for all and helping to better connect the LGBTQ community to one another and provide support, GEAE formed a regional Gay Straight Alliance (GSA) for LGBTQ youth, as well as hosting educational events for seniors and networking opportunities with other like-minded organizations.

in Erie.




Be sure to check in at the registration table when you arrive. We will take the annual Family Portrait around 4:30 pm, right before the raffle, and there will also be roving photographers.
