acronym for Anti-Retroviral Therapy - a combo of meds taken to make HIV undetectable, which creates no risk of transmission to others. ART also represents creativity and imagination through various forms of expression. The ECHTF is collaborating with the Erie County Department of Health, Community Health Net, PA Thrive Partnership, and Journey to a Trauma Informed Life to bring ART to this year's World AIDS Day event.

The program will include a memorial segment for those no longer with us due to HIV / AIDS. If you would like a loved one to be recognized, you can submit their name via email to Gary Snyder, the chair of the Erie County HIV Task Force, at gsnyder@ eriecountypa.gov. Panels from the AIDS Memorial Quilt will be loaned for display at the event as part of a small portion of the world's largest mobile visual project, which recognized over 100,000 lives ended prematurely by HIV. Red ribbons for awareness will be provided to wear in conjunction with red ribbons with names written upon them, which will be displayed on the library lobby windows for the month

of December.

The ECHTF is a collaboration of local organizations and individuals dedicated to educating, supporting, and advocating for people living with HIV/AIDS, along with preventing the spread of HIV. Today, medications and programs are available to not only prevent HIV transmission but allow individuals to live full, productive lives. Erie Votes

As the diverse voices of Erie County came together at the ballot box, the anticipation surrounding the election results grew. Now, let's delve into

the outcomes that will shape the future of local governance, reflecting the collective decisions made by the community in this pivotal electoral moment.

Erie City Council's 4-year term featured a Democratic sweep, with Kathleen Kathy Schaaf leading at 31.5%, followed by Ed Brzezinski at 28.7%, and Tyler Titus at 26.4%. Democrat Pete Sala secured victory in the race for Judge of the Court of Common Pleas, District 6, commanding 57.7% of the votes and defeating Republican Eric Mikovch, who garnered 42.3%. The competition was fierce for Erie County Controller, but incumbent Democrat Kyle Foust prevailed with 58.4% of the votes, while Republican Wade Root secured 41.6% of the support.

Erie County Council elections saw incumbent Democrat Terry M. Scutella reclaiming District 1 with 59.3% of the votes, overcoming Republican Cody Foust's 40.7%. In District 3, Democrat Rock Copeland triumphed with 63.3%, surpassing Republican Kim Hunter at 36.7%. District 5 witnessed a tight race, with Democrat Chris Drexel securing 53.0% of the votes, narrowly defeating incumbent Republican Brian Shank, who received 47.0%. In District 7, Re-

publican Ellen Schauerman emerged with 50.2% of the vote, overcoming Democrat incumbent Lorraine Dolan (39.0%) and Independent candidate Rita F. Bishop (10.8%).

City of Erie Earns 100 on Human Rights Campaign's 2023 Municipal Equality Index

Erie, PA - November 16, 2023 – Demonstrating a continual commitment to equality, diversity, equity, and inclusion, the City of Erie has earned a score of 100 on the Human Rights Campaign's 2023 Municipal Equality Index (MEI) for the second year in a row. The MEI is a nationwide evaluation of 506 cities that examines how inclusive municipal laws, policies, and services are of the lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer (LGBTQ+) people who live



and work there.

Mayor Joe Schember said, "Our city's leaders have worked hard to create an environment where every LGBTQ+ resident, employee, and visitor can thrive. I would especially like to thank our LGBTQ+ Advisory Council members who have worked extremely hard to draft the policies and practices that helped us achieve this score as we all strive to make Erie an inclusive community."

Cities are rated based on non-discrimination laws, the municipality as an employer, municipal services, law enforcement, and leadership on LG-BTQ+ equality.

Since Mayor Schember took office in 2018, the City of Erie has concentrated on implementing non-discrimination policies to eliminate prejudice and make Erie a welcoming and supportive community for all LGBTQ+ people.

Community Spotlight #12: Ashtabula Pride, Inc.

Ashtabula Pride Inc. was founded in July 2023 by Michael S. Riffe (Mona Lotz drag performer) of Ashtabula, OH, and Rebekah Beeman of Conneaut, OH. Before becoming a nonprofit corporation of its own, Ashtabula Pride was formerly known as Pride Ashtabula County, which was Ashtabula County's pride festival under the LGBTQ+ Coalition of Ashtabula County, Inc. Riffe, along with Bill Daywalt, AJ Petro, and John Werner brought the county's first festival in 2021 which welcomed over 3.000 attendees to the festival. Due to the amount of work and planning involved, the Coalition's board decided it would be best to relinquish the festival's ownership and turn it over to Riffe and Beeman to create a new and self-sustainable organization. The two formed a board of directors and an advisory board and began planning the first annual Drag in the New Year, which will be held Dec 31, 2023, at the Conneaut Human Resource Center in Conneaut, OH. The event will include dinner provided by Wade's Pastabilities, raffles, a cash bar, a DJ with Dancing, and a drag show hosted by Mona Lotz. The festival will be held on the 3rd Saturday in June from 11 am-9 pm on Bridge Street in the historic Ashtabula Harbor with vendors, food, and entertainment.
