The LGBT Fund grant at the Erie Community Foundation is opening for applications on 9/9/24 and will close on 10/16/24.



Celebrate LGBTQ+ History Month in Erie!

LGBTQ+ History Month is an annual monthlong observance of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender history, as well as the history of gay rights and related civil rights movements. It was founded in 1994 by Missouri high school history teacher Rodney Wilson. LGBT History Month provides role models, builds community, and represents a civil rights statement about the contributions of the LGBTQ+ community. As of 2022, LGBT History Month is a month-long celebration specific to Australia, Canada, Cuba, Finland, Germany, Hungary, Italy, the United Kingdom and the United States.

In the United States, Canada, Armenia, Romania, the Netherlands, Southeast Asia, and Australia, it is celebrated in October to coincide with National Coming Out Day on October 11th October and to commemorate the first and second marches on Washington in 1979 and 1987 for LGBT rights.

Today, LGBTQ+ History Month stands as a testament to the enduring efforts of Rodney Wilson and countless others who contributed to this initiative. With each passing year, October continues to be a time for reflection, education, and celebration of LGBTQ+ history and achievements, reminding us of the diverse narratives that enrich our collective history. Through this commemorative month, the journey towards inclusivity and acceptance continues, significantly impacting society.

Erie has a long history of LGBTQ+ culture and activism. To help preserve that history, Aging with Pride, an organization for older LGBTQ+ individuals, is working on an Erie LGBTQ+ Archives Project in collaboration with Penn State University Behrend. There is already a small archive of historical LG-BTQ+ materials at Behrend, and Aging with Pride is compiling other materials to add to that collection. This material only represents a small amount of the rich LGBTQ+ history in Erie. Plans are underway to develop a more comprehensive "community archive" that will capture our past and what is happening now. Groups and individuals will be invited to participate in this ongoing archives project as it moves forward. This effort will be similar to other efforts nationwide, such as in Harrisburg and Philadelphia, to preserve local LGBTQ+ history for the future.

October is the perfect time to announce the development of this project. Please watch for more information about this Archives Project and how you may be involved.

Discrimination Survey 2024

On October 1, the Pennsylvania Equality Project is launching a new survey about discrimination in education and the workplace. The new survey will run while the current Housing Affordability and Sustainability survey is in progress. The discrimination survey will focus on issues related to intimidation, harassment, bullying, and other related behaviors in the classroom and the work environment. All survey responses will remain confidential. The survey is open to all Pennsylvanians in the LGBTQ+ community and our allies who have faced discrimination based on perceived sexual orientation and gender identity issues. There are no age restrictions for this survey. Both the Housing survey and the Discrimination survey end December 31, 2024. Intersex Awareness Day

The annual Intersex Awareness Day will be celebrated on Saturday, October 26. On this day back in 1996, the first public demonstration of intersex people took place in Boston, MA, at the annual conference of the American Academy of Pediatrics.

At that time, the now defunct Intersex Society

of North America and their allies demonstrated and shared their pains, denouncing non-consensual infant genital surgery, and demanding the medical industries to take notice. Sadly, doctors dismissed the activities as a vocal minority in a New York Times article the following year.

Intersex Awareness Day highlights the fact that intersex people face violence, discrimination, stigma, harassment, and persecution on account of their characteristics, which do not fit the binary notion of typical male or female bodies. Further, we are reminded that all people everywhere are created equal and should be afforded equal dignity and respect regardless of their sex characteristics.

The Red Zone

The "Red Zone" is a critical and often overlooked period on college campuses, referring to the first six to eight weeks of the academic year when students, particularly freshmen, are at the highest risk for sexual assault. This period is marked by a convergence of factors that make new students especially vulnerable, including their unfamiliarity with campus resources, a desire to fit in, and increased social activity, often involving alcohol.

During the Red Zone, incoming students are navigating new social environments and building relationships, which can sometimes lead to situations where boundaries are crossed. The pressures of adapting to college life can also make students less likely to recognize or avoid risky situations.
